

With Thanksgiving over and the holiday season just beginning... Oliver is the perfect little throw to keep your feet warm in bed or your lap warm while knitting those holiday gifts!



General:

Yarn :: 8 skeins of Lion Brand Wool-Ease Thick & Quick, 106 yards / 97 meters, shown

in Fisherman

Needles:: US19 / 15.0mm

Gauge :: 8 rows/8sts per 4 inches

Notions :: cable needle (if needed), tapestry

needle

Special Notes:

- C8F :: hold four knit stitches in front, knit four stitches, knit held stitches
- C8B :: hold four knit stitches in back, knit four stitches, knit held stitches
- 4x1 Cable Front :: Hold four knit stitches in front, purl one stitch, knit held stitches
- 4x1 Cable Back :: Hold one purl stitch in back, knit four stitches, purl held stitch

Recipe:

- CO 102 stitches (1 selvedge, four knit border stitches, 1-32 of chart x3, 1 selvedge)
- Slip selvedge, knit four border stitches, follow chart row 1, knit one
- Slip selvedge, follow chart row 2, purl five
- Continue knitting chart pattern while maintaining the stockinette borders until blanket is as long as you want!

To customize width for a smaller or larger blanket, CO a multiple of 32+6 stitches for the right side border and selvedge stitches
